EFFECTIVE DATE

This information bulletin is effective upon date of issue.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this information bulletin is to advise the WorkSource Centers (WSC) and YouthSource Centers (YSC) that the Homeless Service Professionals Job Fair will take place on March 26, 2020.

BACKGROUND

On March 7, 2017, Measure H: Los Angeles County Sales Tax for Homeless Services and Prevention was approved by voters. Measure H provides a 0.25 percent county sales tax for 10 years to provide funding for homeless services and prevention. It is projected to raise \$259 million in funding in its first year (source: Los Angeles Times article, "Los Angeles County Supervisors endorse a spending plan for Measure H homelessness tax," dated June 13, 2017).

The increased funding provided by Measure H has led to over 800 jobs being currently available across the homeless service delivery system in the Los Angeles area. In order to fill these positions, the Mayor's Office is hosting a Homeless Service Professionals Job Fair on Thursday, March 26, 2020 from 10 a.m. until 1 p.m. at Watts Labor Community Action Committee (WLCAC), 10950 S. Central Avenue, Los Angeles, CA 90059. The hiring fair is open to all interested job seekers throughout the greater L.A. area. Over 40 service provider employers are confirmed to attend with open positions ranging from case managers and outreach workers to housing navigators and supervisors. Resources will also be available for jobseekers to practice their interviewing skills and review their résumés onsite before talking to employers.
