PURPOSE

In partnership with the City of Los Angeles (City) Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD), the City's Youth Development Department (YDD) is hosting the 2024 Youth Expo. The purpose of the Los Angeles (LA) Youth Expo is to centralize resources available to youth including on-site job hiring, career and workforce development workshops (i.e., mock interviews, resume-building workshops), healthy meal preparation workshops, mental health services, community engagement and leadership opportunities, and more.

BACKGROUND

The LA Youth Expo is a one-stop, grand resource fair targeting youth ages 14-26 and their families. The YDD has established the LA Youth Expo as an annual event, founded in 2023, through collaboration with other City departments, departmental partnerships, and community-based organizations. Collectively, we execute a framework with the primary goal of providing city-wide youth populations with resources that improve their holistic well-being – that is, career, financial, social, community, and physical.

The Youth Expo is intended for youth and their families to address the following strategies of Youth Development established by the <u>Citywide Youth Development Strategic Plan</u>: Basic Needs (and Stability), Health and Wellbeing, Recreation, Academic Achievement and Education Enrichment, Leadership Development, and Career Readiness and Financial Empowerment. The City seeks to support community-based partners by providing youth employment, navigating City systems and resources.
