ANGELENO CORPS AGE ELIGIBILITY UPDATE**

## **EFFECTIVE DATE**

This directive is effective upon date of issue.

## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this directive is to update age eligibility requirements under the Angeleno Corps program to align with California for All programs.

## **BACKGROUND**

The Angeleno Corps program is a centerpiece of Mayor Eric Garcetti's equity and justice agenda and a core investment of the City of Los Angeles (City) in young Angelenos' workforce development and career pathways. Beginning in FY 21-22, the Angeleno Corps is a 10-month, intensive service, support, and education program designed to engage young Angelenos in community recovery efforts in our City's neighborhoods most impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

## **PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY**

Eligibility for the Angeleno Corps program included the following:

1. City of Los Angeles residents
2. 18 to 24 years-old
3. Have valid U.S. work authorization
4. Meet income eligibility requirements
5. Full-time students attending a school or vocational training program

## **DISCUSSION**

The Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD) has secured funding through the California for All Youth Workforce Development Grant awarded by the State of California. The California for All grant increases the eligibility for program participants from 24 to 30 years of age.

**REQUIRED ACTION**

EWDD is extending the eligibility of participants to include young adults ages 25 through 30 in order to align with California for All programs.
