The Annual Plan for PY 2023-2024 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) indicates the vision, policy and budget recommendations for the City of Los Angeles Workforce Development System. The Annual Plan further documents the workforce development programs administered by the Economic and Workforce Development Department. These programs include up to sixteen (16) WorkSource Centers (WSC) and fourteen (14) YouthSource Centers (YSC).
